Our initiatives include

- The implementation of Positive Behaviour for Learning as a school-wide approach to behaviour.
- The implementation of individual sensory profiles including procurement of resources and development of spaces.
- Targeted professional development opportunities for teacher aides through fortnightly teacher aide meetings, twilight sessions and student and pedagogy specific professional development.
- Capability building for all staff as identified in our Differentiated Collegial Engagement Framework
