

# Next Step 2022 Post-School Pathways

## Kuraby Special School



This is a summary of the post-school pathways of students from Kuraby Special School who completed Year 12 and gained a Senior Statement in 2021. The results are from the *Year 12 Completers Survey*, which is conducted approximately six months after students completed Year 12.

### 85.7% response rate

6 out of 7 Year 12 completers from this school responded to the 2022 survey.

### Post-school pathways



In 2022, three Year 12 completers from Kuraby Special School continued in a meaningful post-school pathway.



Two respondents were participating in further education or training, both in campus-based study.



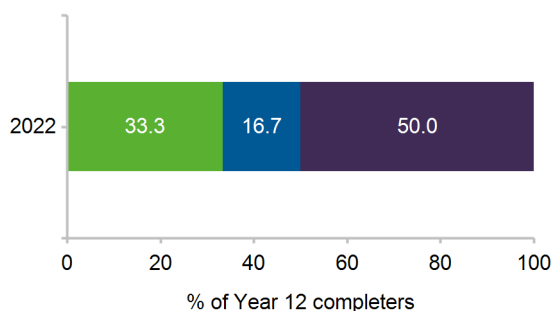
There were no respondents transitioning into employment.



One respondent was not in education, training or employment but was attending a day service.

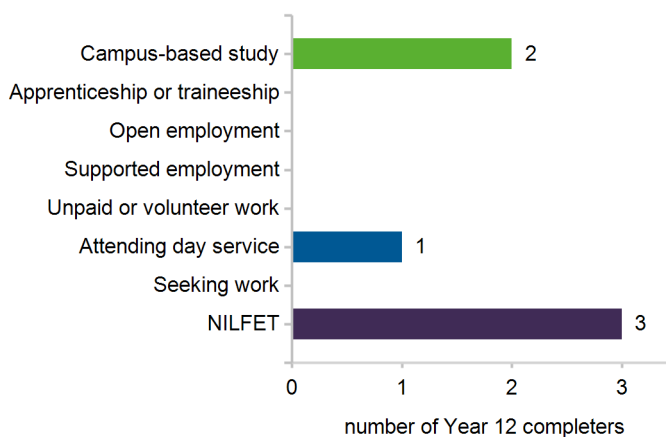
The post-school pathways of Year 12 completers from special schools were categorised into eight *main pathways*. Respondents who were in education, training or employment as well as attending a day service were reported in their education, training or employment pathway. ## Post-school pathway categorisation

### Education and Training

Campus-based study <sup>a b</sup>	Studying at Certificate I, II, III, IV, Diploma, Advanced Diploma, Associate Degree or Bachelor Degree level (excluding apprentices and trainees).
Apprenticeship or Traineeship <sup>b</sup>	Employment-based apprenticeship or traineeship.

### Employment

Open employment <sup>b</sup>	Undertaking full or part-time work in a non-supported employment environment and not in an education or training category.
Supported employment <sup>b</sup>	Undertaking full or part-time work in a supported employment environment and not in an education or training category.
Unpaid or volunteer work <sup>b</sup>	Undertaking unpaid work—including vocational placements, internships, work experience and trials—or volunteer work.

### Attending day service

Attending day service	Attending a day service one or more days per week and not in an education, training or employment category.

### Not in a meaningful pathway

Seeking work	Looking for work and not in education, training, employment or day service.
NILFET	Not in education, training, employment, day service or seeking work.
